European Funding (2014-2020)¹

Over the 2014-2020 period, a total of 1,508 entities based in Catalonia received European funding, which represents 22.0% of the total number of beneficiaries in Spain during the period as a whole. These beneficiaries took part in 4,855 EU-funded projects, which represents 28.4% of all projects with Spanish participants. Based on the quantity of funding achieved, Catalan beneficiaries obtained €2,009.3M, which represents the 21.9% of the total European funding obtained by Spanish beneficiaries.

From 2014 to 2020, Catalonia was ranked 16th among the EU28² for obtaining EU funds. This level of funding is very similar to that obtained by Finland (€2,043.8M) and ahead of countries such as Portugal (€1,961M) and Hungary (€1,813.8M).

Horizon 2020 (H2020)³ is the main funding programme in Catalonia. In terms of the funds allocated under this programme, the competitiveness, excellence, and innovative capacity of Catalan entities have enabled Catalonia to receive 1,7 billion € and 3,202 projects in 2014-2020, which represents 2.5 % of total H2020 funds (one point higher than the amount corresponding to it based on population (1.5% of the EU)).

Finally, Catalonia was the European region with the most companies awarded grants from the EU's SME Instrument programme. 246 Catalan SMEs (4.5% of all grant recipients) were awarded more than €108M in funding (3.8% of the total budget).

<u>Project title: RETRIEVE. Reintegration of photovoltaic panel waste back into manufacturing as high value products</u>

• **Description:** In RETRIEVE we aim to combine PV upstream value chain organizations with beyond state-of-the-art recycling processes and techniques to improve circularity within the PV sector. RETRIEVE targets the upcycling of the components of the End of Life (EoL) solar panels, enhancing the material quality to meet current requirements for re-introduction into the PV value chain. RETRIEVE will increase the circularity and minimize the environmental impact of the PV industry by developing and demonstrating cost effective recycling technologies for the different components of a solar module; recycle glass to current PV specifications, purify production waste and EoL silicon to solar grade quality, recover silver and heavy metals, and polymer valorization with carbon capture. By lowering the financial burden of material recovery and increasing the value after recovery, RETRIEVE makes the overall module recycling process more profitable, and the project opens new paths for commercialization.


